

LUTYENS TRAVELING FELLOWSHIP

Purpose:

To promote the appreciation and knowledge of the work of Sir Edwin Lutyens by funding a period of individual travel and research on his work and legacy.

The Lutyens Traveling Fellowship provides a \$7,000 award for emerging professionals in architecture, art history, interior design, historic preservation, or the decorative arts. Fellows will execute a travel program oriented towards academic research related to any aspect of the work of Sir Edwin Lutyens.

Eligibility:

To be eligible, an applicant must be an emerging professional having graduated from a degree program in architecture, historic preservation, art history, the decorative arts, or interior design, within the past 15 years.

Submission Requirements:

- Research proposal with up to five (5) sheets supporting the area of study (text, drawings/plans, images)
- Completion of the program application, available online at https://lutyenstrustamerica.com/
- Two letters of recommendation
- Curriculum vitae and proof of graduation from a qualified academic program

Award Conditions:

- The recipients will plan and execute a period of independent travel and research, to be followed by a report on the results of the project. The report may include a paper/blog, photo journal, or sketch book and will culminate with an illustrated presentation.
- The Fellowship recipient will receive an award of \$7,000 for all expenses. The first payment (80%) will be distributed prior to travel, and final payment (20%) after receipt of the deliverables.

Application Deadline: All materials must be submitted and received by February 15th, 2024.

1) Research proposal with up to five (5) sheets supporting the area of study

- -8.5" x 11" format
- -May include drawings/plans, photos, and other graphics necessary to illustrate the proposal
- -Applicant's proposal should clearly demonstrate how Lutyens' work is crucial to the research program.

2) Curriculum vitae

3) Proof of graduation from a qualifying degree program

Additional materials and applications not meeting the submission requirements will not be considered by the selections committee.

All materials must be received by February 15th, 2024.

Program Notes:

Applicants will be notified before April 5th, 2024, of the Committee's final choice for the award.

Visa applications and travel arrangements will be handled by the applicant.

Program format, details, and criteria may be revised from year to year, and may be suspended at any time, subject to the discretion of the Fellowship committee.

Applicants may be asked to participate in a future Lutyens Trust America webinar.

Deliverables will be considered archivable materials and may be retained for future use by the Lutyens Trust America.
